PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



As we gather tonight to celebrate SCMA's 45th foundation anniversary, I feel honored for the opportunity to serve our fellow alumni, scholars and others who benefit from our advocacy. I am humbled by the tremendous support shown by everyone here tonight.

When I was first asked to be president in late 2020, my first thought was "we're in the midst of a pandemic; why don't we just continue with the current administration and stay dormant until this plague goes away". But when the request became a plea, I thought I'd step in and turn the pandemic into an opportunity to adapt and revitalize our organization. We installed our new mostly-young set of officers and worked via zoom meetings. We formed a strategic revitalization program with five main goals: (1) energizing and growing our membership, (2) growing our scholarship and career-assistance programs, (3) using technology to improve our operations, (4) growing our funds with new fund-raising methods, and (5) increasing the quality of our socialization programs to strengthen our bond as Mapuans.

I am pleased to report that our revitalization program is bearing good fruit. (1) We have over 20 enthusiastic New Lifetime Members, seven times the typical number before the pandemic. With our relentless outreach, members who were no longer participating have come back in force. (2) We continued to support our existing Mapua University scholars during the pandemic, and now have three new scholars. We are upgrading our free Engineer-in-Training (EIT) certification exam review classes. (3) We created a highly functional website that enables us to do almost all of the paper-and mail-based tasks on-line. We now use a cloud-based central filing system, electronic payment systems and hybrid in-person/on-line meetings. (4) Our dwindling funds have increased five-fold, thanks to new fund-raising programs such as the Scholarship Matching Fund, the Qualified Charitable Distribution Program, Facebook fundraiser, and generous support from our reinvigorated members and friends. (5) Our socialization activities such as hiking, summer picnic, Christmas party, and this Dinner-dance gala have attendance that well exceeded those before the pandemic. Our "Team Mapua" won the Battle of the Alma Mater golf tournament, and we are looking forward to a record participation in our upcoming Mapua Golf Tournament on June 25. Friends, ladies and gentlemen, fellow alumni, we're on a roll. Viva Mapua!

Tonight, let us have fun and celebrate. Let's have a nice dinner, dance, reunite with old friends and make new ones. We will have live entertainment and raffles to punctuate the night. We invited distinguished speakers to inspire us all as we aspire to be a more benevolent, humanistic and service-oriented organization. We will induct our new set of officers, pledge our new lifetime members, recognize our founding presidents, and give presidential awards to SCMA members for their recent outstanding contributions.

When we depart this event, I urge fellow Mapuans and supporters to continue onward with the momentum of revitalization that has been set in motion. Please volunteer your time, talent and treasure, and you will be rewarded physically and spiritually. History of Southern California Mapua Alumni (SCMA)

In the summer of 1976, a group of seven Mapua Institute of Technology alumni gathered at Griffith Park, Los Angeles, California, to discuss the possibility of forming an alumni association. Four of these alumni, Raul Domingo, Marte Tobias, Lolita Ramos, and Rudy Jardinel, were Los Angeles County Department of Public Works engineers. They were joined by Rudy Corpuz, Prudy Morales and Roman Aquino. At the time, their main purpose was to help newly migrated Mapuans adjust to life in America and find engineering jobs, especially at LA County Department of Public Works.

In the early fall of 1976, at Ven Mungcal's sister's birthday party in Pasadena, California, the group agreed that Mr. Mungcal invite as many Mapuans as possible to further discuss the formation of an alumni association. In the summer of 1977, the first general membership meeting and family picnic was held at Griffith Park, Los Angeles. Incorporation papers and bylaws were drafted. The new association was named "Mapua Alumni of Southern California" (MASC) and was registered as a tax-exempt non-profit public charitable organization with the California Secretary of State. The association was later re-incorporated as "Southern California Mapua Alumni" (SCMA).

Raul Domingo was elected the first president of the association and served for three years until 1980. The first induction ball was held at the Ambassador Hotel in Los Angeles. Due to lack of funds, the officers paid in advance with their own money as loan to the association. Ven Mungcal was the second elected president and during his term from 1981 to 1982, the association started raising funds to expand its programs to include granting scholarships to needy but deserving students at our Alma Mater, Mapua Institute of Technology in Manila. This program, which continues to the present, proved to be the most successful endeavor that the association has undertaken.

The years went by, and as membership expanded, the organization was able to fund more scholarships and help young engineers in their careers through free EIT review classes and networking. The expanded leadership brought in Mapuans with strong devotion to lead the association as presidents, namely, Glory Montemayor, Marte Tobias, Val Ramos, Robert Masangkay, Roger Villamil, Red Revilla, Pert Arca, Nene Umali-Irlandez, Edith Garcia-Ramos, Precy Ordinario, Rudy de Torres, Tino Quiaot, Rick Guanio, Joe Rigonan, Tony Ballesteros, Joey Uy, Dan Nable, Glee Quinoveva Quiaot, Cecilia Lopez Brod, and the current president, Ross Papilla. SCMA's notable developments over the years include hosting of the MapuaWorld 2002 convention, affiliation with NAMA (National Association of Mapua Alumni), implementation of TOM (The Outstanding Mapuan) award program, formalization of our scholarship partnership with Mapua Institute of Technology (now Mapua University), restructuring of our status as a 501(c)(3) non-profit charitable organization, and modernization of our operations. As the torch of leadership passes on to the younger generation, tonight, we're honoring the three founding presidents: Raul Domingo, Ven Mungcal and Marte Tobias.

New Fundraising Programs of Southern California Mapua Alumni (SCMA)

a qualified 501(c)(3) tax-exempt non-profit charitable organization, FEIN 95-4134441

One of the objectives of SCMA's strategic revitalization plan is to grow our funds through new fundraising programs. We continue raising funds with our traditional fundraisers such as dinner-dances and golf tournaments, but these new programs are needed to increase our number of scholars and improve our education/career assistance programs such as our free EIT Review program. The new fundraising programs presented here are the Scholarship Matching Fund (SMF) program, the Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) program, and the Facebook Fundraiser.

Scholarship Matching Fund (SMF) Program

The SMF program was launched on SCMA's Christmas party on December 4, 2021, and was started due to the very low balance of our Scholarship Fund as fundraisers were canceled during the pandemic, whereas the necessity to help our needy but deserving scholars was greater than ever. Donations go solely to the SCMA Scholarship fund and are fully tax deductible as we are a 501(c)(3) organization. SCMA members (called patrons) who pledge to donate \$500 each from the matching fund pool from which other donations are matched. This Matching Fund Program provides a means for donors to share their blessings for the benefit of SCMA's scholars, while having the effect of doubling the impact of their donations. This program is also open to non-Mapuans as donors. The seminal idea for this program was from Joe Riganon, Jr., PE, ME'62, 2009-2010 SCMA President, and was developed with the current president, Ross Papilla. To date, we have raised \$6,325 from 8 patrons and 13 donors, and donations are continuing to come in. To date, patrons include Joe Riganon, Jr., Ross Papilla, Lourdes Cronin, Pete Aguilar, Ben Cubacub, Berwyn Salazar, and Rey Principe. To date, donors include Anonymous, Cynthia De Leon, Rosalinda Tandoc, Larry Dela Cruz, Rico Macalalad, Cheryl Sandel, Roald Bueno, Roland Allen Madrazo, Janina Lyka Baiza, Cecilia Rosana, Young Ones, and Jesse San Miguel. Thank you to all participants for your love and care of our scholars. This program is ongoing and we welcome pledges and donations throughout the year.

Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) Program

The QCD program takes advantage of a law passed by Congress in 1985 that allows recipients of Required Minimum Distributions (RMD's) to donate distributions to qualified 501(c)(3) charities, crediting those distributions toward their RMD, without counting those distributions as income, thereby yielding significant tax benefits for the donors. Only individuals who are 72.5 years old (or 70.5 before 1/1/2020) and have IRA accounts (not 401k or 403b) are eligible to donate via this program. Distributions must be made by your financial institution to a qualified charity such as Southern California Mapua Alumni. Consult your financial advisor and work closely with the SCMA president to ensure that your donation will yield your desired tax benefit. After the fund is transferred to SCMA, the SCMA president will contact you regarding your preference on how SCMA may use your donation. You may choose for it to go to the General Fund for SCMA's operating expenses or the Scholarship Fund for scholarship purposes only, or both in specified amounts. The pioneer for the QCD Program is Daniel G. Nable, ME'71, MSMT, 2015-2016 SCMA President. Dan and Ross (current president) started discussing and developing this program in late 2021, and Dan was able to donate a substantial amount via this program in February 2022. Thank you, Dan, for your very generous donation. May the Lord bless you and your family more. If you or someone you know is interested in donating to SCMA via the QCD program, please let us know.

Facebook Fundraiser

The Facebook Fundraiser was started as an experiment by the current president when two weeks before his birthday, his son Michael suggested that he direct his birthday gifts from his FB friends to his favorite charity, Southern California Mapua Alumni. This little experiment worked, and it was a lot of fun. If you'd like to do the same, from your FB home page, go to Fundraisers, Select Non-profit, and type Southern California Mapua Alumni. Facebook will automatically find SCMA, as we are a qualified 501(c)(3) charity. This little experiment yielded for SCMA well over the \$200 goal within a week.
